

**Opportunities in Private Practice – Clinical Experience in Oregon**

1. Doctor Small Animal Veterinary practice with rural location in Grants Pass, Oregon. Caseload is a mixture of surgery and medicine with approximately 50 cases per week. Practice performs a large variety of procedures but may be infrequently due to 1 doctor. Practice is 35 years old and has provided a good living in a rural setting. Practice also consults on 2000 head dairy. Practice will likely be available for sale in next 5 years at a good value. Housing could be negotiable for right person.

2. Doctor Small Animal Veterinary practice in Coos Bay, Oregon. Caseload is a mixture of medicine, emergency care, dental surgery, and soft tissue surgery. Our practice focuses on individualized wellness care over the lifetime of our patients. Weekly team meetings are held for training in animal care skills and client service. We encourage students to participate to their ability/desire in case management. This is intended to be an opportunity to learn and develop in a fun atmosphere.

3. Dr. Doug Mcinnis: Doctor Small Animal Veterinary practice with two locations in Klamath Falls, Oregon. Caseload is a mixture of surgery and medicine with approximately 200 cases per week. We work closely with our local shelter and if the student desires we are able to provide additional training with surgery cases, mostly ovariohysterectomy and castration procedures. If housing is needed, we will provide housing for the student.
